Basic Points To Be Noted

• There are 29 letters in the Arabic Alphabet: اب ت ث *ج ح خ* د ذ ر ز س ش ص ض ط ظ ع غ ف ق ك ل مر ن و ه ء ى

• Arabic is written and read from right to left:





Certain letters have 'thick' or 'thin' sounds:



 Arabic has vowels which prolong the sound of a consonant letter :

مَلِكِ (king) مُلِكِ (master)















Surah Al-Naas

- This is the last Surah of the Holy Qur'an (Chapter 114)
- It has seven verses
- The meaning of it's name is 'The Mankind' or 'The People'
- It is the best small Surah to learn the rule of Noon Ghunnah

Rule of Ghunnah

 Ghunnah means continuous nasal sound for about two seconds
